PASCUA YAQUI CHRISTMAS OUTREACH

It's that time of year again! Once again, Advent is blessed to celebrate with the Elders in the in the Old Pascua Yaqui Village (Tucson, Arizona) at the Santa Rosa de Lima Mission. Details are as follows:

- The Pascua Yaqui gift tree will be located in the east narthex beginning **November 19.**
- Simply remove a gift envelope from the tree, place cash/check in the envelope and place it in the box provided next to the tree.
- Pre-determined gifts items will be purchased (in bulk) with the funds collected.
- On Tuesday, December 5, interested Advent parishioners will travel to Tucson (arrival time scheduled for 10:30 am). Pascua Yaqui tribal members will serve a traditional meal to those in attendance.
- At 12:00 PM, tribal elders will arrive at the church and gifts will be distributed until approximately 1:00 PM.
