November 5: Andre House of Hospitality

Founded in 1984, Andre House provides services to the poor and homeless population in downtown Phoenix. Dinner meals, laundry services, shower facilities and clothing items are provided to thousands of individuals each year. The organization also supports a transitional housing facility. November 12: Sojourner Center

Sojourner Center has provided a safe haven for victims of domestic violence since 1977. The Center has 134 shelter beds and 32 transitional apartments.
